## HOSTING GRANDMOTHER DRUM

**LOCAL EVENTS:** To sponsor Grandmother Drum, we require a first day minimum with our 4 hr **GrandMother Drum Prayerformance** ceremonial event. Contact us about booking fees.

**GRANDMOTHER DRUM AT FESTIVALS, CONFERENCES AND GATHERINGS:** Grandmother Drum provides a dynamic and unifying forum as the Opening and Closing Ceremonies at any festival or conference. Booking Fees apply to festivals, however costs may vary according to the length of the festival and the scheduling of additional workshops at the festival. Please contact us about the specific needs of your festival or conference.

**ALASKA AND USA EVENTS:** To sponsor Grandmother Drum, we require a first day minimum with our 4 hr **GrandMother Drum Prayerformance** ceremonial event followed by three days of booked workshops. Transportation of Grandmother Drum is additional. Contact us about booking fees.

**INTERNATIONAL TOURS:** Our World Peace Tours are usually 3-4 months or 14-18 weeks in length. Due to the extensive costs of transporting Grandmother Drum in foreign countries with a staff of 4-6 people, we require a minimum of 8 fully booked weekend venues to successfully launch an international tour. During a three-month tour, we also offer one or two extended programs of 5-10 days. This often culminates as an equinox or solstice program.

## BECOMING A HOST SPONSOR:

On USA and International Tours, we require a booking of a minimum of 4 days of events.

Sample Host Venue:

Day 1: Grandmother Drum Prayerformance

Day 2: Sound Healing and the Power of the Drum Workshop

Day 3: Sound Healing and the Power of the Drum Workshop

Day 4: Private and Group Healing Sessions

1. The following will cover all hosting details for the above 4 days of events:

**Day 1: GrandMother Drum Prayerperformance** To sponsor Grandmother Drum, we require a first day minimum with this half day(4hr) ceremonial event. Join us for a dynamic ceremonial and interactive performance of drumming, primal rhythms, prayer, dance and celebration for the whole family. There is a guided journey with the GrandMother Drum that requires approx 30 minutes of focused meditation and silence. Host Sponsors provide facility, promotion and take tickets at the entrance. Contact us about specific booking fees and venue requirements.

**Day 2-3: Workshops at the same venue:** After the first day minimum of our Grandmother Drum Prayerperformance, we offer one to three days of workshops. We require a twenty (20) person minimum on all workshops. Contact us about daily workshop fees. Host sites add to workshop fees any additional costs to cover their facilities and advertising costs. Host sites register all participants and provide facility, promotion and sound technician. For every ten participants, one host staff can attend the workshop at no cost.

**Day 4: Private and Group Healing Sessions:** Private 1-2 hour sessions are available for participants to deepen the previous days teachings with White Eagle Medicine Woman or any of our tour staff healers. Contact us for details of each practitioners session work. Please visit our website for session costs. Host Sponsor can add to this session fee any additional amount to cover their own facilities.

**Group Healing Sessions:** This 3 hr Group Channeling Session with White Eagle Medicine Woman is available in the evening from 6-9pm. Please visit our website for Group Session costs. Host Sponsor can add to this session fee any additional amount to cover their own facilities.

#### **ADDITIONAL HOST SPONSOR DETAILS:**

1. Host Sponsors provide gathering place for the prayerperformances, workshops and sessions.
2. Host Sponsors promote the event in their community (see us for press packets, posters or to arrange radio and television interviews). Articles and photos from previous tours can be

accessed from our website or by emailing us.

3. Host Sponsors provide an onsite sound technician. (The GMDRUM Project travels with their own sound equipment.)
4. Host Sponsors provide 2 volunteers to collect prayerperformance tickets at the entrance. Advance tickets will be available on our website for prayerperformances and workshops. You can make advance tickets available for your specific events if you choose.
5. Volunteers: Host Sponsor provides 4 volunteers to be available as of 10 am on the Prayerperformance Day to assist in carrying Grandmother Drum into the performance space and for any set up needs. A maximum of 6 volunteers (including the Host Sponsor) can attend the Prayerperformance at no cost.
6. Host Sponsors are recommended to make contact with the local multicultural community, peace organizations, or drum groups for their involvement in welcoming the GrandMother Drum Prayerperformance into their community. We reserve 20 minutes at the opening of the Prayerperformance for any welcome from local cultural elders or performers.

#### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:**

1. **Food, Accommodations and Parking Details for All Venues:** Accommodations, food and parking for staff is always appreciated and in some venues required for the GrandMother Drum and staff. White Eagle Medicine Woman requires a private room.
2. A **Merchandise Booth** space and 3 tables are provided for us free at all our events. 100% of the money collected from our booth sales at the events go directly to supporting our international peace work.

**BOOKING:** Please contact us for booking fees and contracts on all prayerperformances, workshops and sessions. Please know the GrandMother Drum International Peace Project is in very high demand. It is highly recommended to book your events at least a year in advance. All deposit fees are made payable to The Whirling Rainbow Foundation. The Whirling Rainbow Foundation accepts Paypal, Visa, Mastercard and international bank transfers.
